

## *Dierama pendulum*

### Common names

Wedding Bell (South Africa), Fairy Bell (South Africa)

[Dierama pendulum](#) is a fully hardy perennial evergreen bulb with pink flowers in late Spring, early Summer, late Summer and mid Summer. The flowers are trumpet shaped arranged in a drepanium inflorescence. It looks best in Spring and Summer.

### Soil

*Dierama pendulum* grows in soils ranging from a pH of 6 (acidic ranges from 5.6 to 6) to 8 (slightly alkaline ranges from 7.6 to 8). It is adapted to chalk, clay loam, loam, loamy sand, sandy clay, sandy clay loam and sandy loam soils, and prefers high fertility.

### Growth

This arching bulb and has a clump forming growth form, and has an ultimate height of 1.3m / 4.3ft and spread of 0.8m / 2.6ft. It can take 2-3 years to reach its ultimate height.

### Leaves

It has green leaves. They are ensiformis in shape.

### Uses

Architectural, city courtyard garden, container plant, cottage informal garden, flower arranging and flower border and bed.
